Sadly most monuments in India have become victims of ugly graffiti and sometimes leave us wishing we could be invisible when pillars of time have messages of love and doodles of hearts carelessly scribbled on them. We need to respect property in our own homes and schools first. For instance writing on classroom desks and doors does not speak well of both the students and the school. "When my friends from Dubai asked me why people had written on the walls of the Bibi Ka Maqbara, I did not know what to say," says XYZ student of B.A.F.Y., still clearly at a loss for words. Caring for the environment means not only being concerned about nature but also showing respect for public property. While on a college picnic or excursion tour to historical sites it helps to read up and know all about the place you will be visiting – when it was built, by whom, perhaps even how long it took to build and what cost. This will help realise the importance of the site and highlight our responsibility to keep our priceless heritage intact.

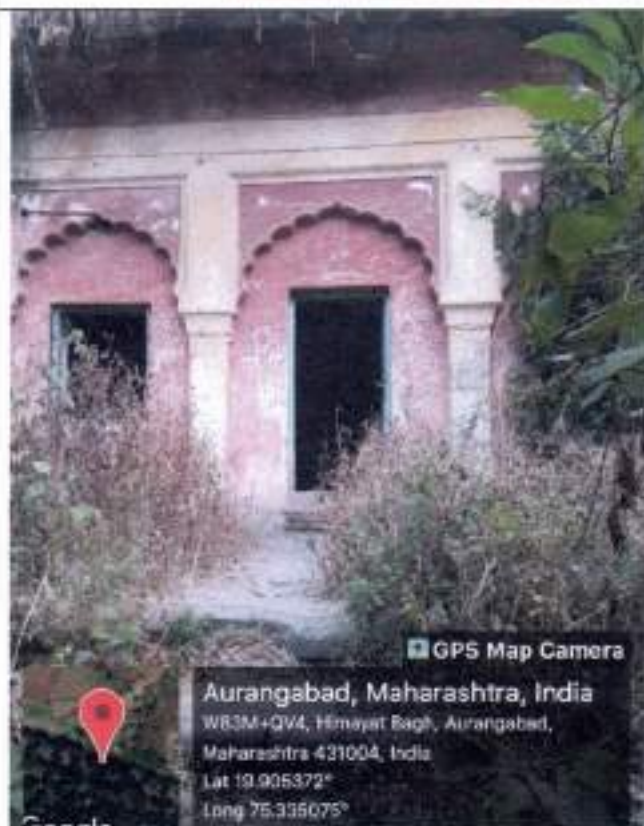

Details of the Programme: Guest Lecture & Poster Presentation on occasion of **Constitution Day**

Goals and objectives:

The objective of the Guest Lecture was to acquaint students about the values that are enshrined in Indian Constitution and convince them to imbibe these values into their day-to-day behaviour. It is only when we go to the path shown by the Constitution, will we be able to create a law abiding citizenry.

Highlights of the programme :-

Associate Prof Shejul, Vice- of the Institute, in his opening remarks brought out that Indian people have heterogeneous value system. To develop a modern and egalitarian society, we face a problem from where to start. The starting point could be understanding values emerging from terms Justice, Liberty, Equality, Fraternity, Secular and Democratic at various levels of Society. Associate Prof Shejul provided a crisp account of need and historical development of constitution. He elaborated the concept of sovereign nation and role of constitution in defining relation between State and its Subjects. He brought out that after the period of Renaissance, people realised the purpose of constitution. He explained that Constitution sets out norms to restrict powers of state. He explained basic features of Indian Constitution to students. He also mentioned that after independence, the Constitution makers were more focused not only to have a constitution with political purpose but also a constitution

based on Social economic as well as political advancement of India as a nation. Towards the end of the session, Prof. Narang discussed the basic principles enshrined in the Preamble of Constitution.

Highlights of the program:

As a part of value addition to the curriculum the Department of Political Science & College organized the guest Lecture Followed by Poster Presentation on the occasion of Constitution Day.

The said Programme was organized on 26 November 2021. Total 15 participated in this guest Lecture & Poster Presentation. The students listened the Guest Speaker very curiously. They take running notes during lecture. After completion of the lecture students actively take part in Question – Answer Session and asked questions to the Guest speaker.

Relevance and outcome :

Students must know about Basic Principles and features of the Constitution. After this lecture they can be make aware of their constitutional rights and can perform their duties efficiently.

And students came to know about practical functioning of the Constitution and its importance to seek justice.

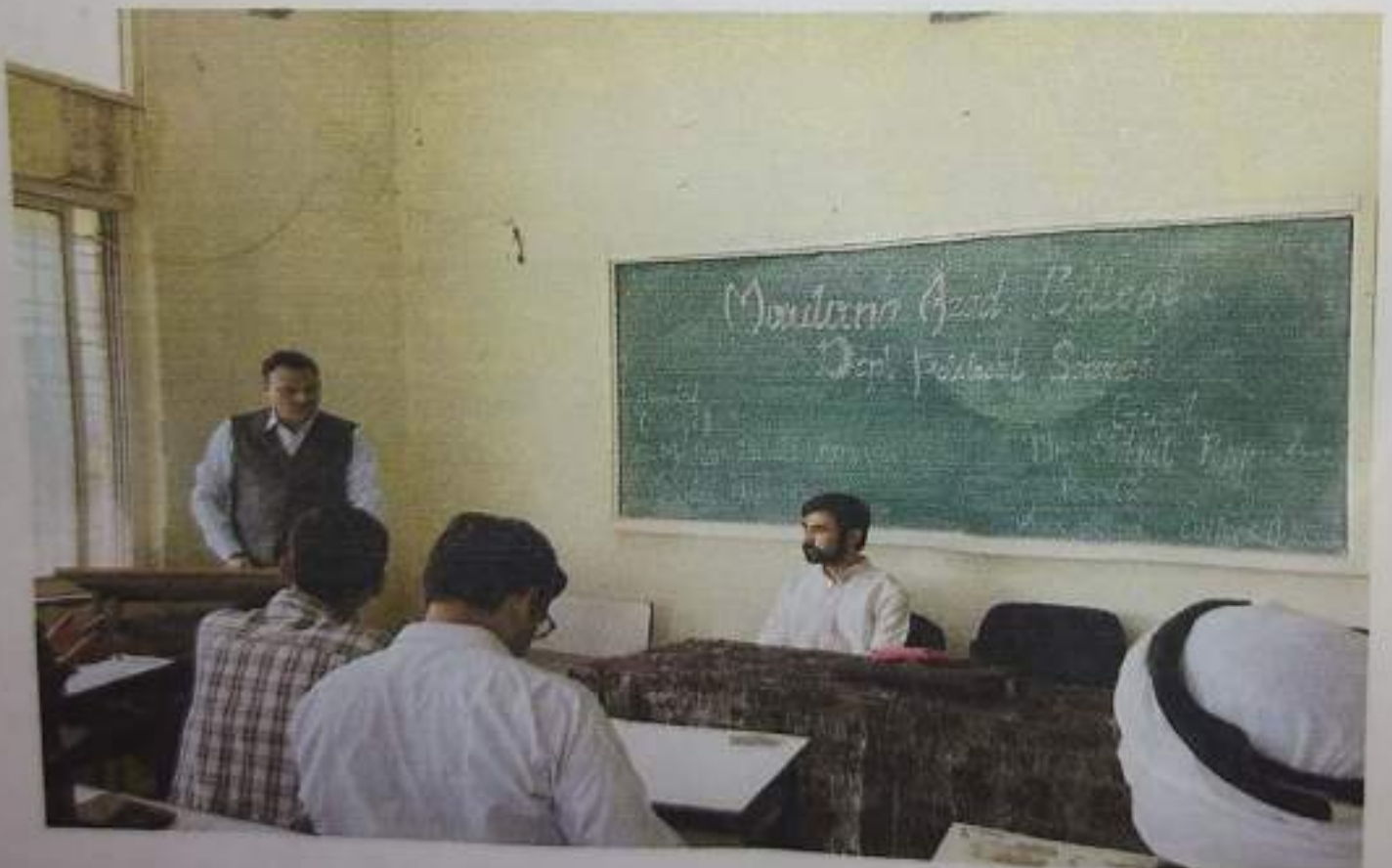

Goals and objectives:

The objective of the Guest Lecture was to acquaint students about the importance of Right to Vote and convince them to Cast their Vote in every election. Which will helpful to create a responsible citizen.

Highlights of the Programme:

Assistant Prof. Maimnat Jahan Aara, in his opening remarks talked about voting behavior of Indian people. The power to vote for our country is an important part of a democratic country like India. While many in our country are eligible to cast vote, few are enthusiastic about it. In the 2019 Lok Sabha elections, the voter turnout was 67.11% which is the highest turnout in the history of India. With every election, there has been a positive increase in voter turnout. Such an increase in voting is a positive welcome, as each and every vote counts for a better future of our country.

Ma'am provided a crisp account of need and historical development of Voting system. She elaborated the concept of sovereign nation and role of constitution in defining relation between State and its Subjects. He brought out that after the period of Renaissance, people realised the purpose of constitution. He explained that Constitution sets out norms to restrict powers of state. She explained basic features of Indian Constitution to students. She also

mentioned that after independence, the Constitution makers were more focused not only to have a constitution with political purpose but also a constitution based on Social economic as well as political advancement of India as a nation. Towards the end of the session, Maimnant Maam discussed about changing behavior of Youth Voters.

As a part of value addition to the curriculum the Department of Political Science & College organized a online guest Lecture on " Right to Vote and Democracy" on the occasion of National Voters Day.

The said Programme was organized on **25 January 2022**. Total 22 participated in this online guest Lecture on Zoom Plateform. The students listened the Guest Speaker very curiously. They take running notes during lecture. After completion of the lecture students actively take part in Question – Answer Session and asked questions to the Guest speaker.
